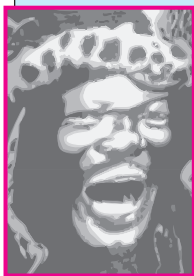


Witwatersrand: township violence increases

Inkatha's feud with the ANC has killed more than 2,800 people since May 1990. Nine areas around Johannesburg have been designated 'unrest areas'. Security measures include roadblocks, cordon and search operations and strict enforcement of curfews
