


# Spy-in-the-phone traces obscene callers

Police working with Hull's municipally-owned telephone company, Kingston Communications, have launched a new system to trap obscene callers

## Existing Telecom service

Police instruct Telecom to ask for a code-word whenever victim's phone is called. This limits the number of suspect callers.

If calls persist police advise victim to record calls on an answerphone, blow a whistle down phone to discourage caller or to change phone number. Police supply a counselling service to help victims



## New system introduced in Hull

During obscene call victims tap in a code on their own phone. This triggers an alarm at the phone company which prints out caller's phone number, name and address and alerts the police
