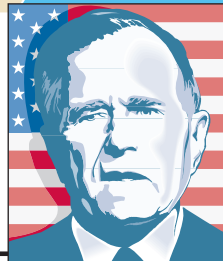
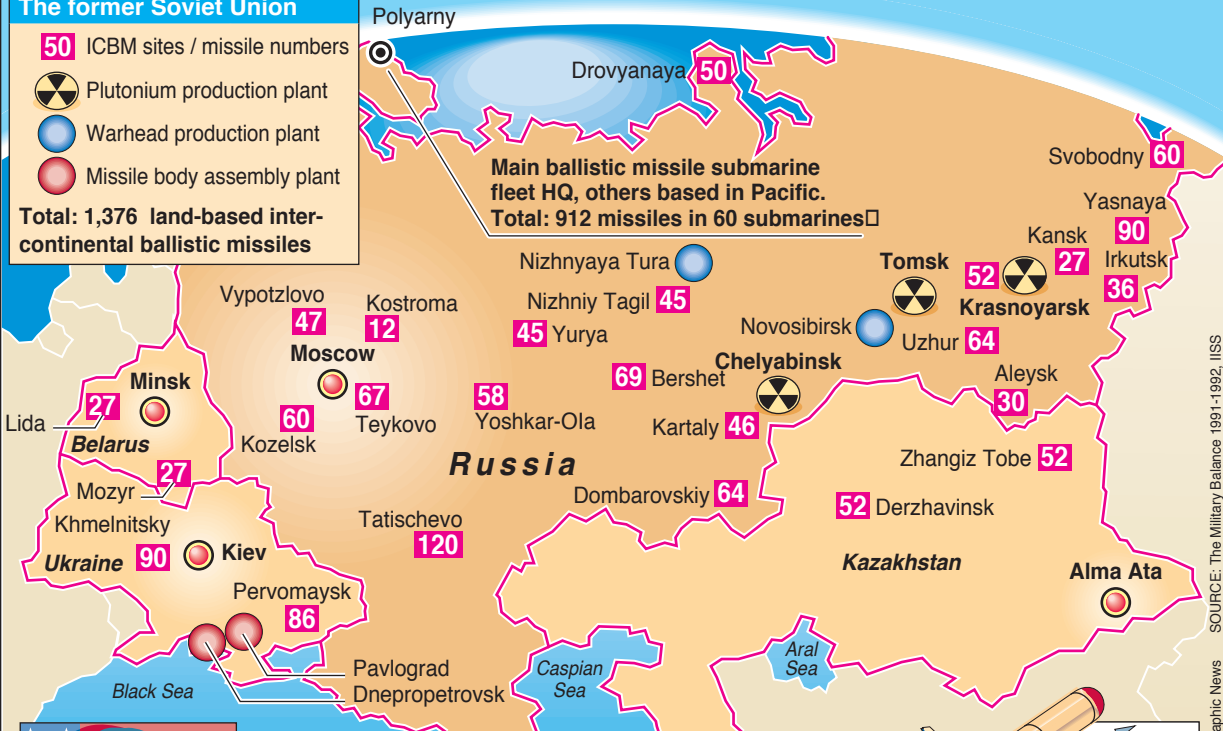


Superpowers plan new nuclear policies

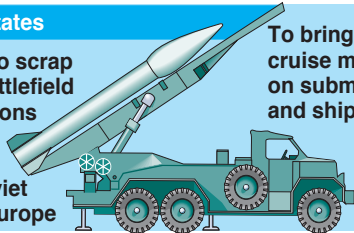
The former Soviet Union

The United States

Bush wants to scrap all tactical battlefield nuclear weapons originally intended to repulse a Soviet invasion of Europe



To bring home all nuclear cruise missiles based on submarines and ships

To cut multiple warhead missiles (MIRVs) based on land and at sea
