

# Freestyle: moguls

Moguls appear for the first time as a full Olympic discipline in Tignes



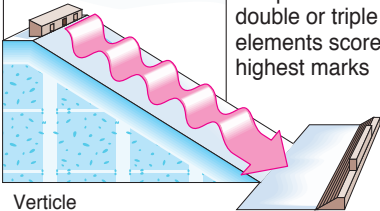
Skiers take the most direct route down a steep slope, turning at high speed over large bumps or 'moguls'



During the descent they must execute two jumps without losing line or rhythm



**Scoring:**  
technical skill of turns – 50%;  
speed – 25%;  
style and degree of difficulty of jumps – 25%.  
Jumps with double or triple elements score highest marks



Verticle drop: 119m

Race distance: 250m
