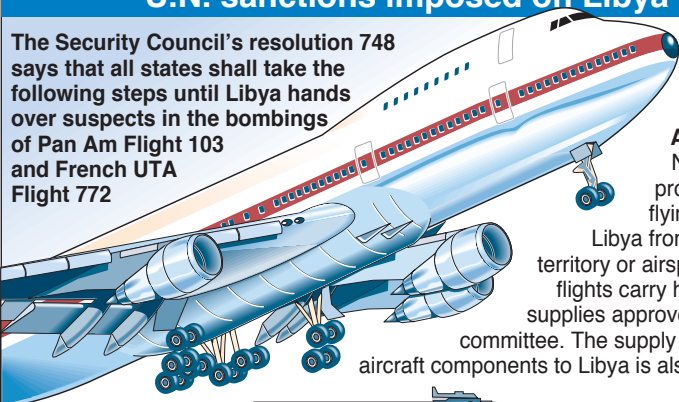


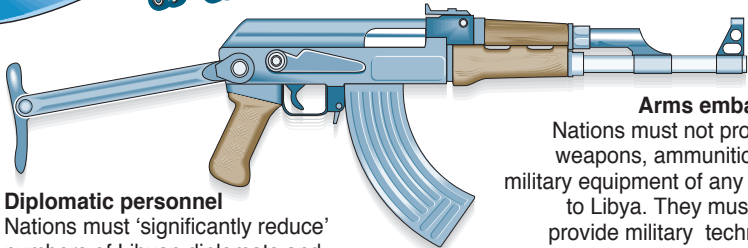
# U.N. sanctions imposed on Libya

**The Security Council's resolution 748 says that all states shall take the following steps until Libya hands over suspects in the bombings of Pan Am Flight 103 and French UTA Flight 772**



## **Air embargo**

Nations must prohibit aircraft flying to or from Libya from using their territory or airspace, unless flights carry humanitarian supplies approved by a U.N. committee. The supply of aircraft or aircraft components to Libya is also prohibited

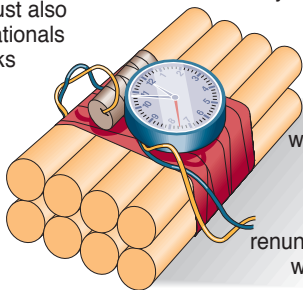
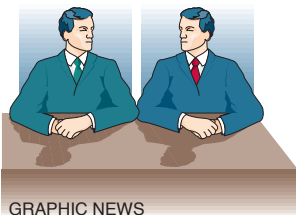


## **Arms embargo**

Nations must not provide weapons, ammunition or military equipment of any type to Libya. They must not provide military technical advice or training, and must withdraw any officials or agents now in Libya for those purposes

## **Diplomatic personnel**

Nations must 'significantly reduce' numbers of Libyan diplomats and restrict the movement of Libyan staff on their territory. All Libyan Arab Airlines offices must be closed. They must also expel or deny entry to Libyan nationals suspected of having terrorist links



## **Terrorism**

Libya must cease all forms of terrorism and withdraw support for terrorist groups. Libya must also demonstrate its renunciation of terrorism with positive actions
