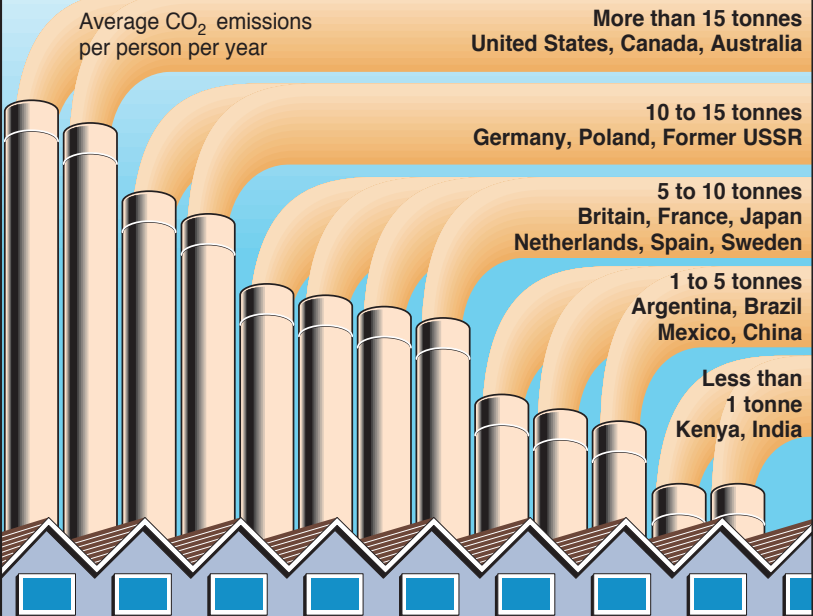


Curbing 'greenhouse gases'
