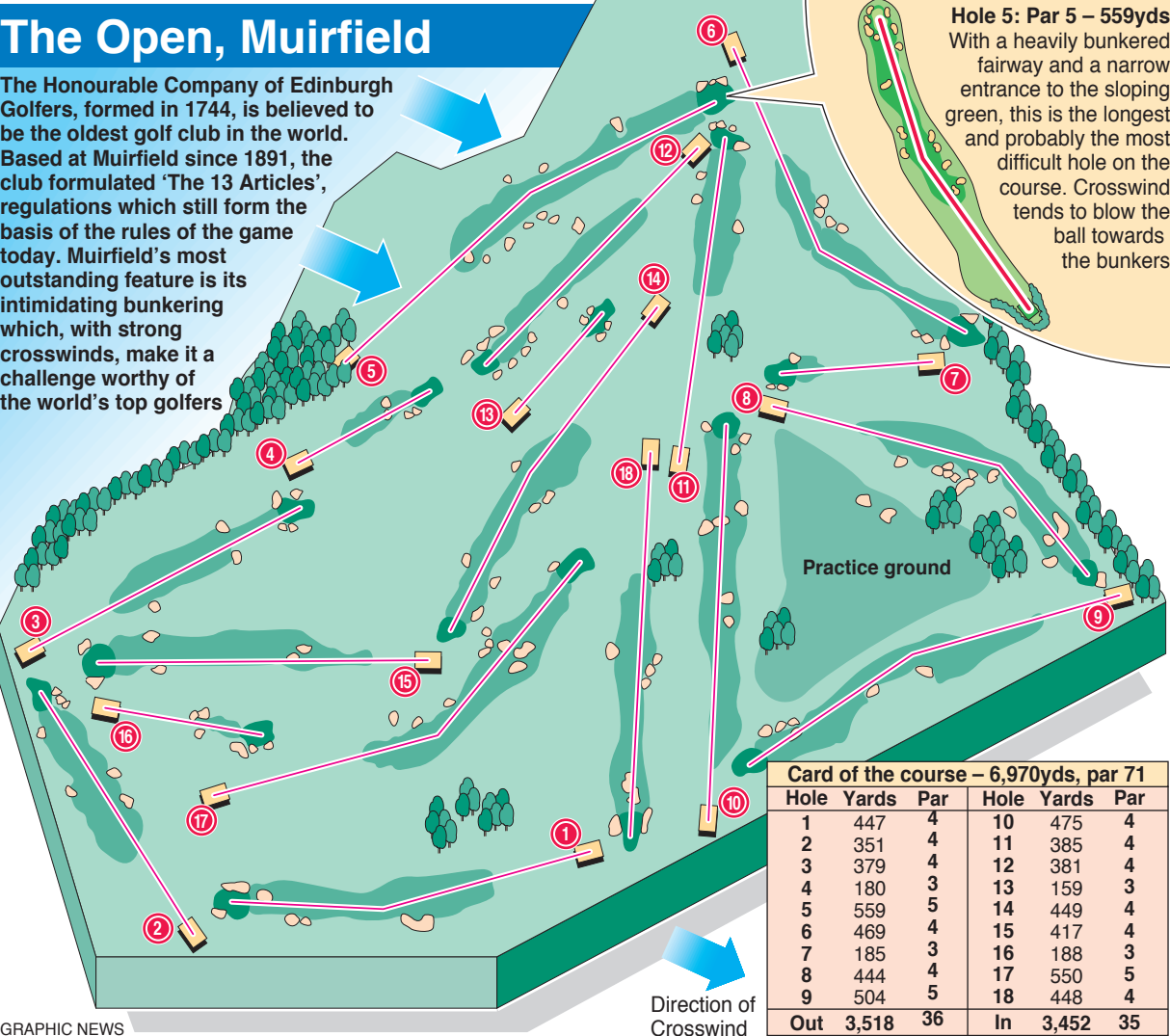


The Open, Muirfield

The Honourable Company of Edinburgh Golfers, formed in 1744, is believed to be the oldest golf club in the world. Based at Muirfield since 1891, the club formulated 'The 13 Articles', regulations which still form the basis of the rules of the game today. Muirfield's most outstanding feature is its intimidating bunkering which, with strong crosswinds, make it a challenge worthy of the world's top golfers

Hole 5: Par 5 – 559yds
With a heavily bunkered fairway and a narrow entrance to the sloping green, this is the longest and probably the most difficult hole on the course. Crosswind tends to blow the ball towards the bunkers
