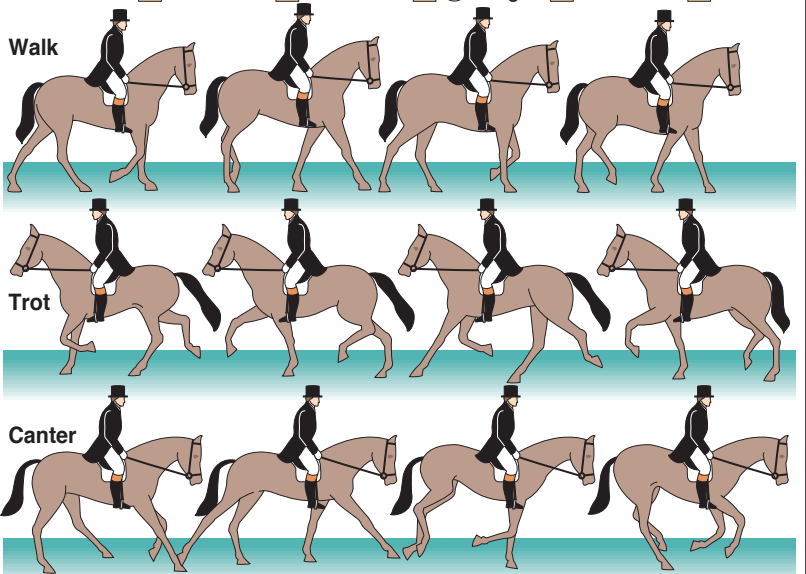
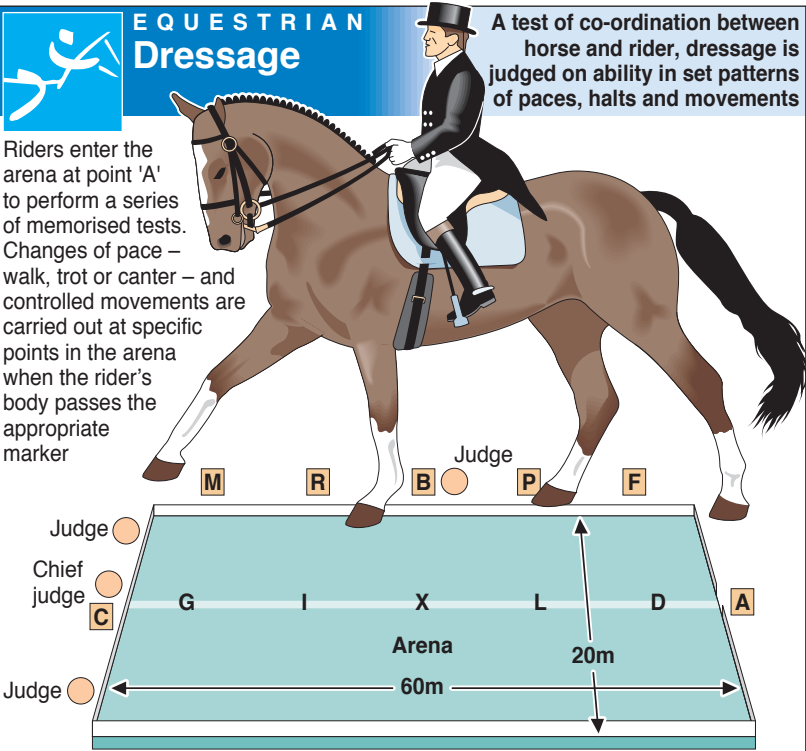




EQUESTRIAN Dressage

A test of co-ordination between horse and rider, dressage is judged on ability in set patterns of paces, halts and movements

Riders enter the arena at point 'A' to perform a series of memorised tests. Changes of pace – walk, trot or canter – and controlled movements are carried out at specific points in the arena when the rider's body passes the appropriate marker



Points are awarded for each discipline by each of the five judges. Four riders compete in the team event with the best three scores combined to form the total
