

Taking on the Green Monster

Home to the 1992 U.S. PGA championship, Bellerive was nicknamed the 'Green Monster' by U.S. Open competitors in 1965, not one of whom could break par. The 7,311 yard course should suit last year's surprise winner, John Daly, who is renowned for his long distance shots
