


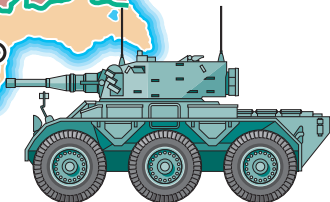




UN to reduce force in Cyprus

Talks on the UN's proposed new border are scheduled to resume in October. As some 550 UN peace-keeping troops prepare to leave, it is hoped that Greek and Turkish Cypriots will reach a peaceful agreement

Britain: Scout car squadron – over 100 men – to be withdrawn by December 15



Canada: Considering pulling out 60 troops, with remaining 500 to leave in 1993



Austria: 63 troops due to leave by December 15



Denmark: Total force of 323 to go by December 15



Finland: Total withdrawal by the end of 1993
