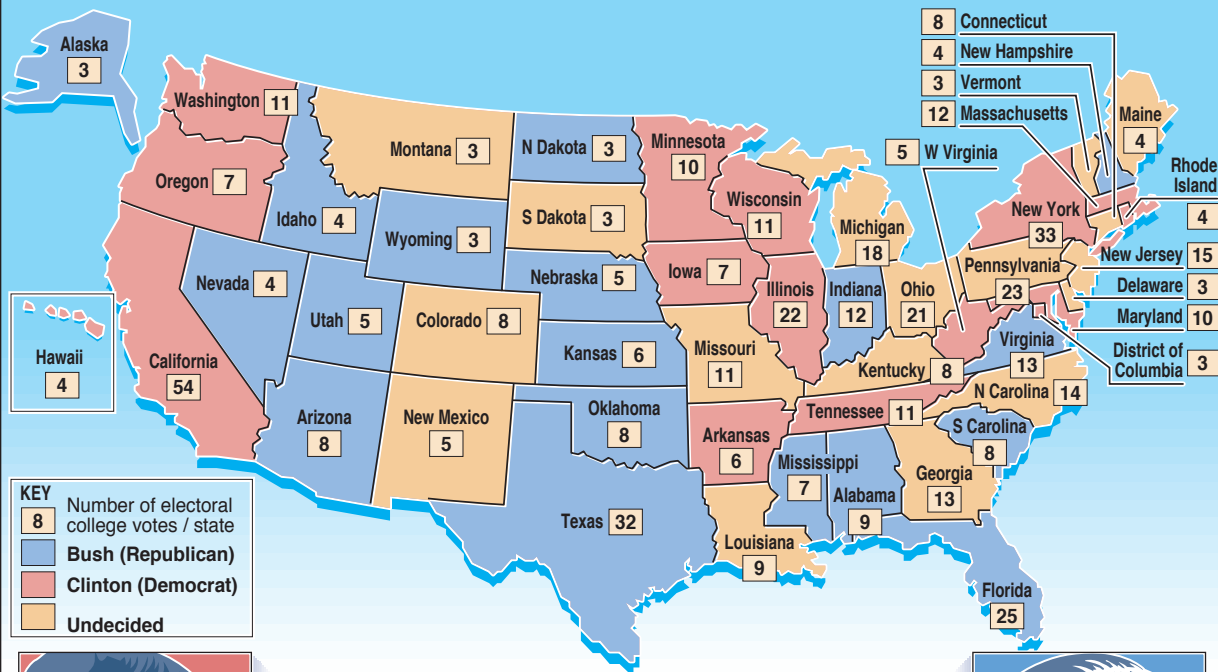


Contest for the White House

Latest polls indicate that Bill Clinton currently leads the U.S. presidential race with a likely 210 electoral college votes to George Bush's 159, while the remaining 169 votes are from states as yet uncommitted to either candidate. The winner will need 270 votes on polling day – November 3



Ross Perot's re-entry into the campaign would affect both candidates with George Bush likely to pay the higher price in lost votes. States where Perot's vote could change the predicted outcome include Washington, Arizona, Texas, Oklahoma and Virginia
