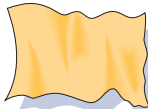




Slippery road. Often indicates oil on track.



Danger: slow down, do not overtake.



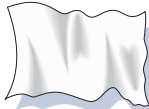
Race stopped: return to grid area.



All clear: shown after a yellow, red or 'oil' flag.



Warning: problem with car that may endanger others.



Recovery or other slow moving vehicle on track.



Warning: you are about to be overtaken. Allow faster car to pass.



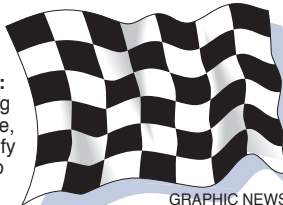
Final warning: give way or risk disqualification.



Shown with driver's number
Warning: unsportsmanlike conduct



Disqualified: return to pits immediately



The chequered flag:
Waved as the winning driver crosses the line, then held still to signify the end of the race to other drivers
