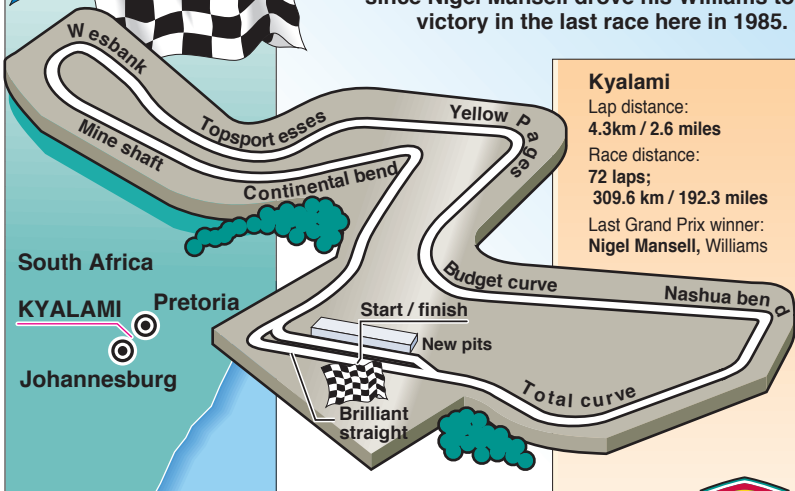


South African Grand Prix

South Africa stages its first Grand Prix for seven years when the 1992 Formula 1 season gets under way on Sunday at the Kyalami circuit. The track has undergone major reconstruction since Nigel Mansell drove his Williams to victory in the last race here in 1985.
