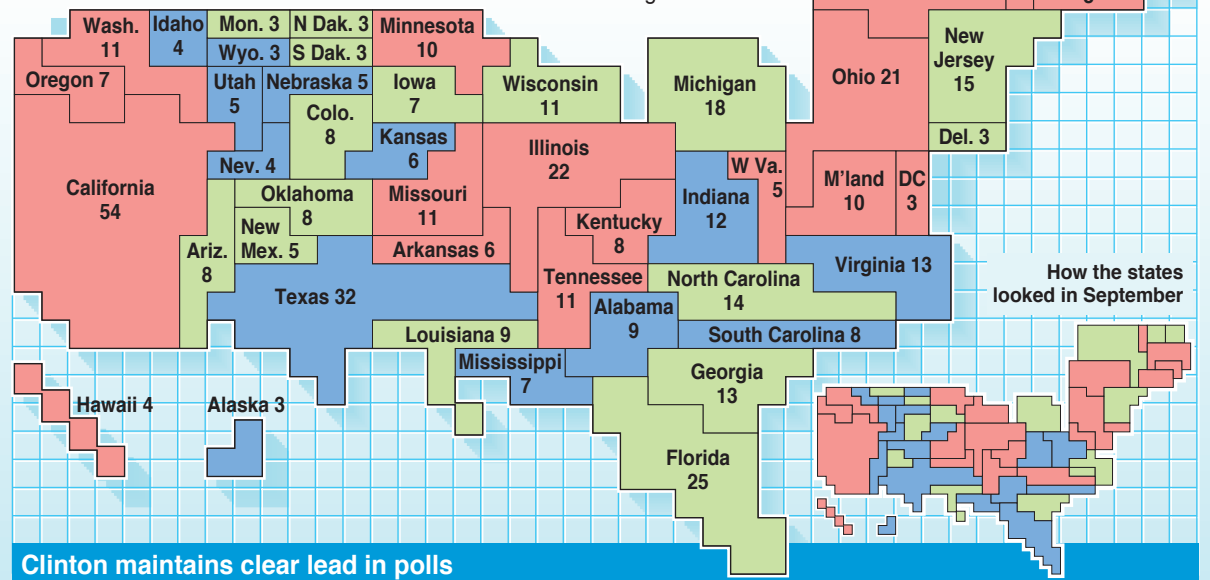


The power of the people

If the map of the United States was redrawn to represent the voting power of each state, it might look something like this. The candidate who wins the popular vote automatically receives all the electoral college votes allocated to that state. Significantly, Clinton is ahead in many states with high numbers of votes

State sizes scaled to electoral votes:
Total 538 (270 needed to win)
