

# Intifada anniversary

The Palestinian uprising which began five years ago – in December 1987 – and which is dedicated to ending Israel's occupation of the West Bank and Gaza Strip, has claimed more than 1,775 lives. Israeli Prime Minister, Yitzhak Rabin, has urged the 1.8 million Palestinians in the occupied areas to accept his offer of limited self-rule as a first step towards peace

## Palestinian deaths

988 killed by Israeli soldiers, undercover units or civilians; 678 killed by fellow Arabs mostly as suspect collaborators

## Israeli deaths

109 including 21 soldiers

## Palestinian detentions

More than 80,000 detained; 6,830 currently in jail including 223 held without charge or trial

## Palestinian homes

301 sealed, 434 demolished

## Court-martials

236 cases brought against Israeli soldiers; 191 convicted
