Toyota, Japan's biggest car manufacturer, has begun production of the Carina E saloon at its new £700m facility at Burnaston. Output is expected to reach 100,000 cars by 1994, rising to 200,000 by the late 1990s. By mid 1995 80 per cent of the car's components will be manufactured in Europe
