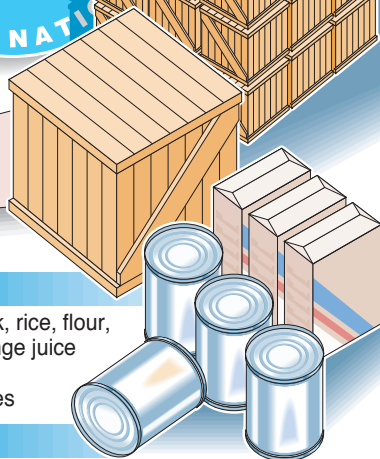
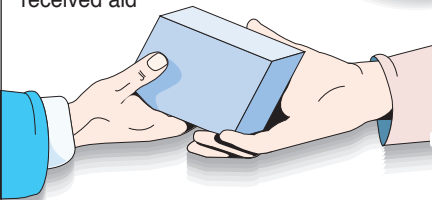
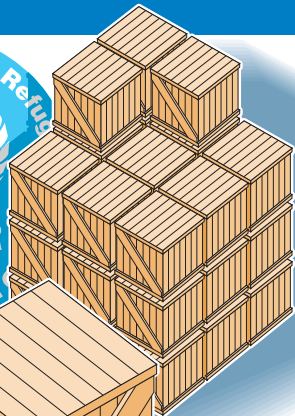


United Nations aid to Bosnia

The U.N. has delivered 150,000 tonnes of aid to Bosnia-Herzegovina since July, an average of 20,000 tonnes a month. Sarajevo has received over 30,000 tonnes of aid which has been distributed to almost all its 38,000 population. An estimated 1.6 million people have now received aid



Types of relief

Food aid: canned beef and fish, dried milk, rice, flour, beans, lentils, noodles and powdered orange juice

Other aid: tents, blankets, plastic sheets, window repair kits and wood-burning stoves

Harassment

In the 14 weeks to mid-January, U.N. convoys were subject to 54 attacks including shelling and vehicle thefts as well as delays at roadblocks
