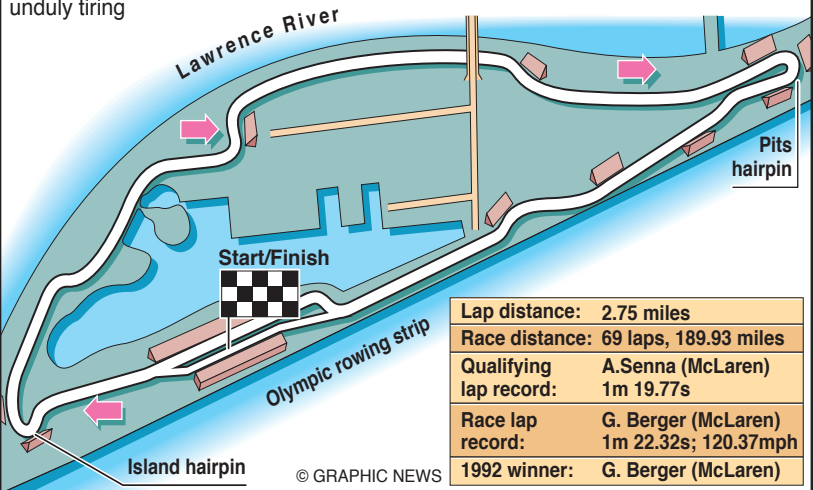


Concentration the key to Canada



Canadian Grand Prix, Circuit Gilles Villeneuve, Montreal, June 13

One of the favourite circuits among the drivers, the bumpy Montreal track makes huge demands on brakes and concentration, especially when wet, but unlike Monaco the lack of any real high-G corners means the race is not unduly tiring
