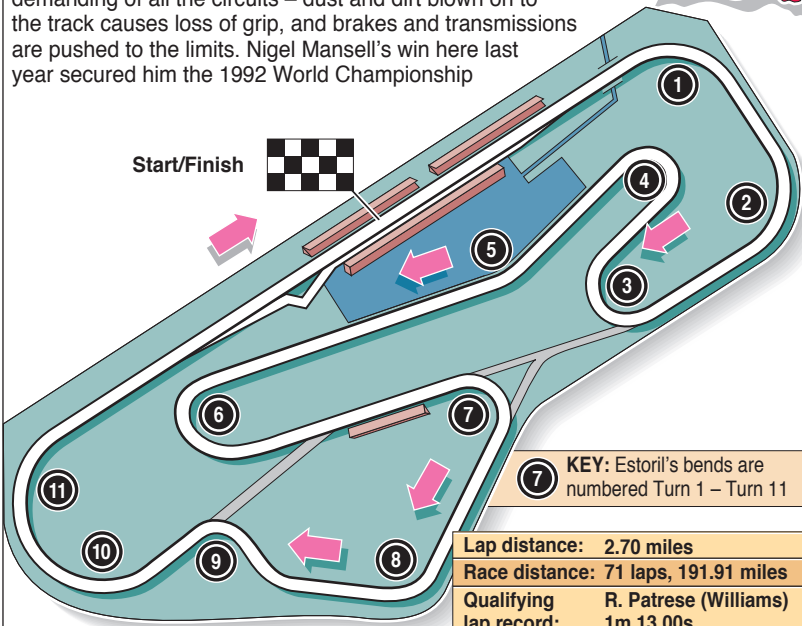


# Grand Prix circus bids farewell to Europe



## Portuguese Grand Prix, Estoril, September 26

The final event in Europe is staged at probably the most demanding of all the circuits – dust and dirt blown on to the track causes loss of grip, and brakes and transmissions are pushed to the limits. Nigel Mansell's win here last year secured him the 1992 World Championship
