


# The world's 10 most endangered species



The World Wildlife Fund has included the Siberian tiger, African Black rhino and giant panda on its latest list of most threatened species. The animals are sought by poachers and sold for oriental medicines, exotic furs or as rare pets in illegal trade worth up to \$3 billion a year


**Siberian tiger:** skins sold for coats and bones ground up for Oriental medicines



**Black rhino:** killed by poachers for their horns – numbers have decreased by 90 per cent since 1970



**Giant panda:** hunted for their skins in remote mountain areas of China



**Brazilian rosewood:**

the only non-animal species in the WWF top ten. This rare wood is used for fine furniture and guitar fretboards, where it is prized for its resonance
