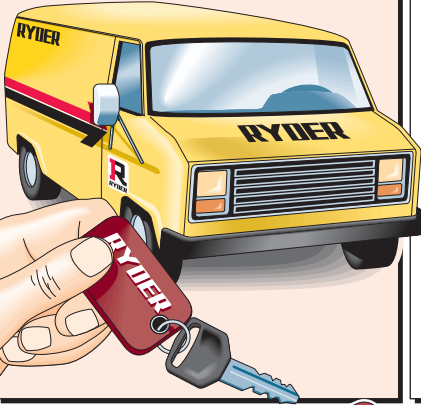


February 23

Salameh rents yellow Ford Econoline E-350 van from Ryder Truck Rental Inc., Jersey City, New Jersey.

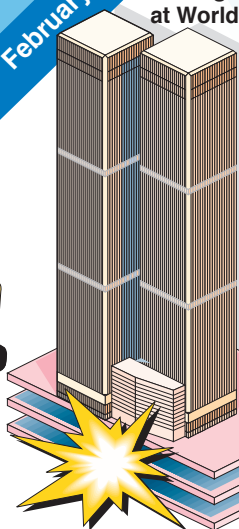
Salameh uses his real drivers' licence and address for identification

March 3

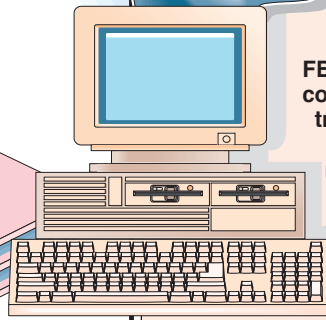
18 inch, mangled fragment of axle with partial identification number is discovered at bomb site. Degree of damage implies axle is from bomb vehicle



FBI agents use police computer network for tracking stolen cars.

Axle identification number is traced to a van rented from DIB Leasing Inc. Jersey City.

FBI now trace the licence number



March 3

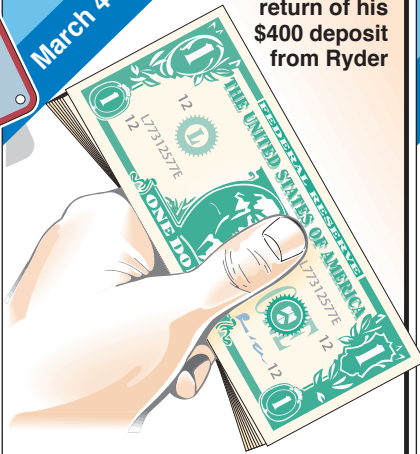

March 4, 10:05 am

Salameh signs document stating he hired the van, receives \$200, leaves and prepares to board a bus. Salameh is arrested by between 8 and 10 FBI agents. FBI visit Salameh's flat and find bomb-making equipment including tools, wiring, manuals on antennae, circuitry and electromagnetic devices
