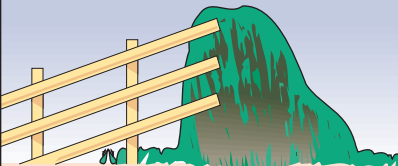


Canal Turn

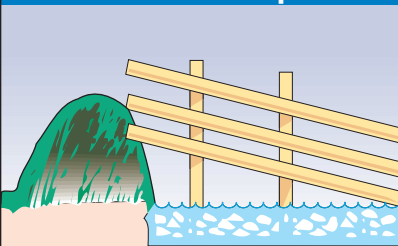


Fence 8 and 24; height: 5ft 0in

Particularly difficult because of its position on the course. The foundations of the fences are made of an almost unbreakable barrier of hawthorn stakes – up to 9 inches below the official height of the fence – these are covered with Norway spruce

Water Jump

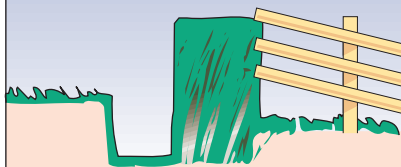


Fence 16; Height: 2ft 6in followed by a 15ft stretch of water

Jumped once, even a slight mistake can be crucial at this fence – the last before turning into the second circuit

The Chair

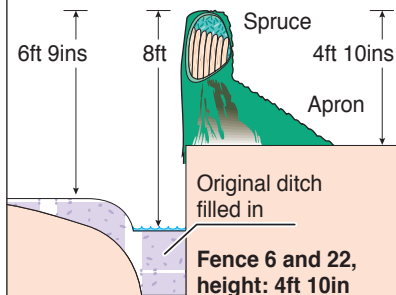


Fence 15; height: 5ft 2in, set after a 6ft wide open ditch

Jumped once, this fence represents a formidable obstacle – and some spectacular grandstand viewing

Fence 6 and 22, height: 4ft 10in

After a number of fatalities at this fence, the acute slope following it has been levelled to give an extra 5ft of landing space, reducing the risk of serious injury to horses
