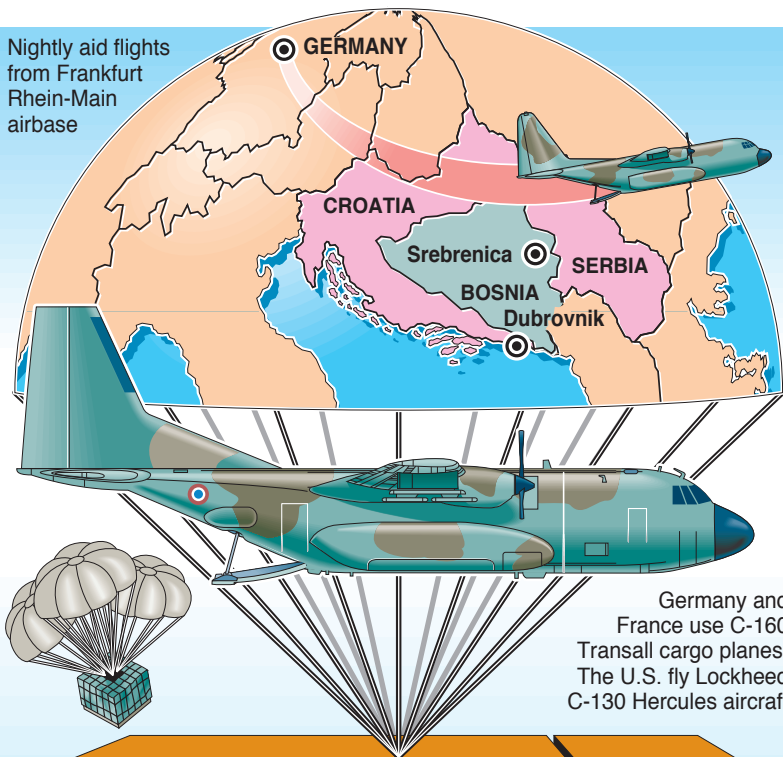


# Germany joins Bosnian airdrop

German Air Force cargo planes have joined U.S. and French aircraft flying aid in airdrops over Bosnia despite Serb threats to shoot down German planes. The Serbs blame Germany for early EC recognition of Croatia and Slovenia and thereby fostering the break-up of Yugoslavia
