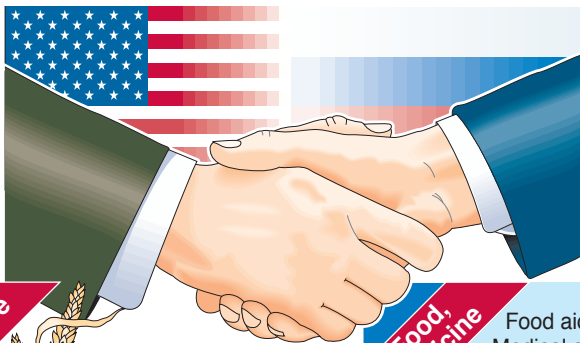


# The U.S. aid package

Baby food, medical supplies, low-interest business loans and grants to dismantle nuclear weapons are included in the \$1.6 billion U.S. aid package to Russia. The initiative also includes the setting up of a 'Democracy Corps' to help Russians understand how democracy and a free market operate

'Food for Progress' package to help Russia to buy U.S. grain and other commodities

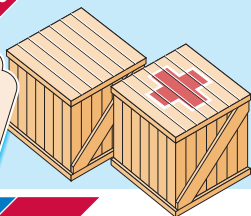

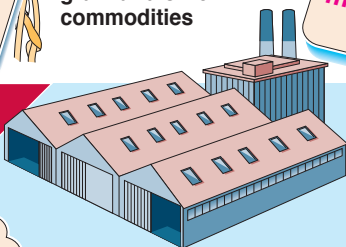

\$38m to repair oil pipelines

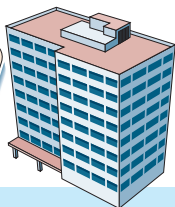
