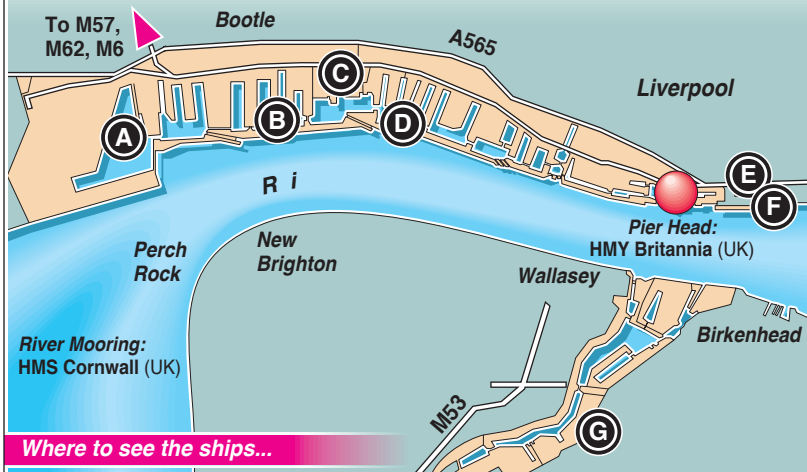


# Liverpool plays host to anniversary fleet
