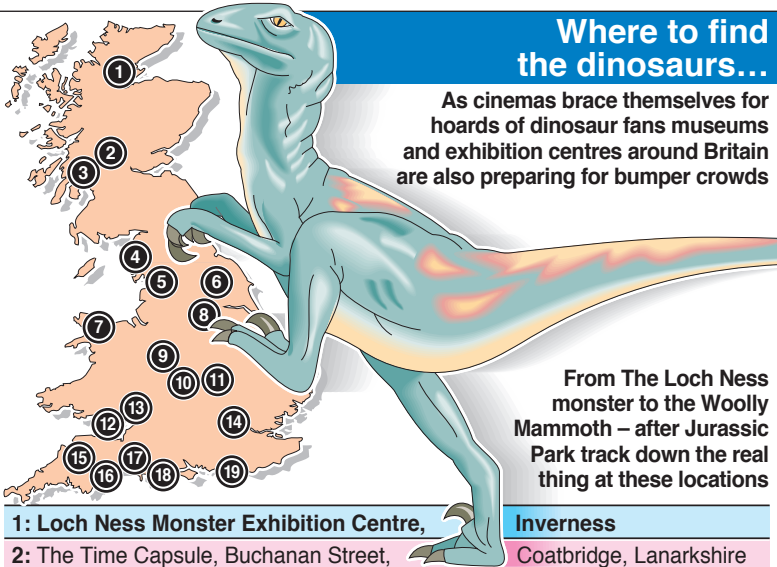


Where to find the dinosaurs...
