

Neo-Nazi attacks fuel U.S./German fears

Polls in Germany and the U.S. conducted by the Mannheim-based Institute for Applied Social Research indicate fears of a return of National Socialism in Germany. A surge in right-wing fervour resulted in 2,584 neo-Nazi attacks on foreigners in 1992 and 1,300 reported up to August this year

Is there a danger of a return to National Socialism?



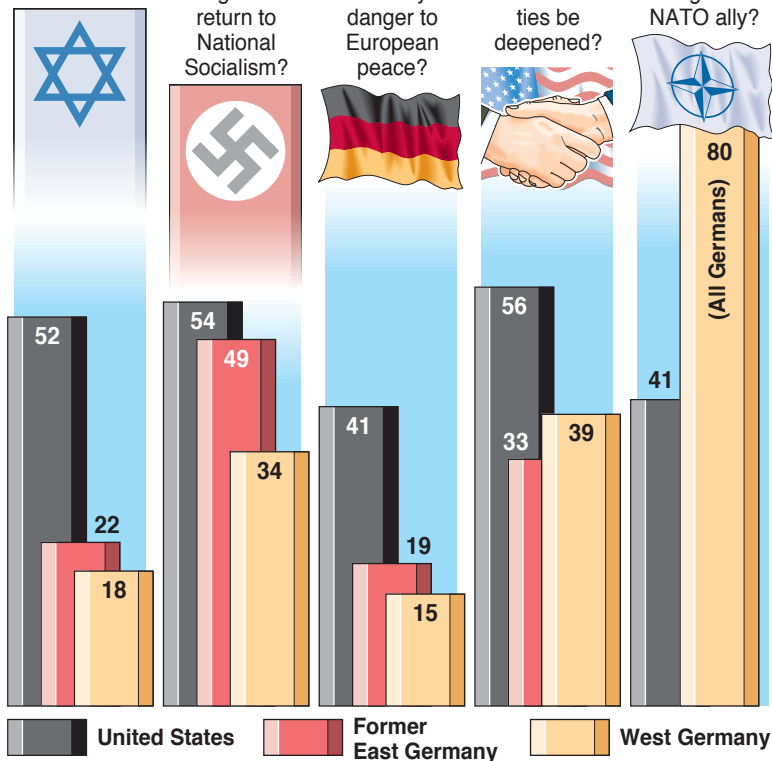
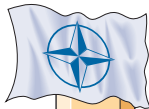
Is unified Germany a danger to European peace?
