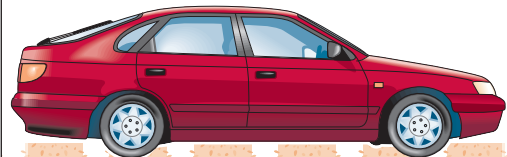


# VEHICLE SECURITY Battle to beat the car thieves

The UK has the highest rate of car theft in the EC, with the chances of having a car stolen in any one year as high as one in 37. With lower insurance premiums possible if an approved model is fitted, effective security systems are fast becoming a high priority with car owners

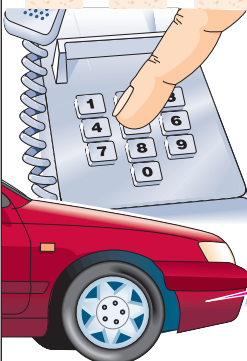
## Stolen vehicle tracking system: *Tracker*

1. Vehicle is fitted with small homing device hidden in any one of 30 places – unknown even to the driver



2. If vehicle is stolen, owner contacts police and Tracker Operations Centre

3. Operations centre broadcasts unique coded signal via nation-wide network to activate unit hidden in stolen vehicle



Tracker immediately starts to transmit silent signal



4. Police cars fitted with tracking computers detect silent homing signal

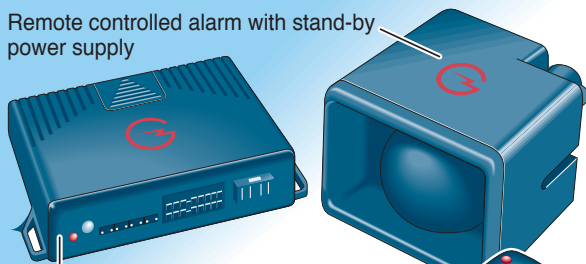
## Electronic / Electromechanical Immobiliser: *Ford Passive Anti-Theft System*

Electronic trigger with over 2 million combinations activates hidden immobiliser to cut fuel supply, ignition system and other electrical circuits

## Combined Alarm / Immobiliser: *Gemini 5160*

Remote controlled alarm with stand-by power supply



Immobiliser and key isolates at least two circuits and features anti-scan, anti-grab code resistance

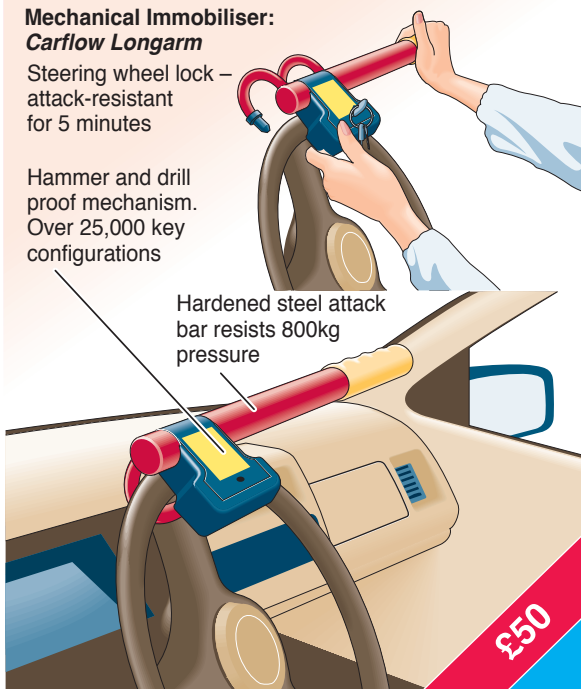

## Mechanical Immobiliser: *Carflow Longarm*

Steering wheel lock – attack-resistant for 5 minutes

Hammer and drill proof mechanism. Over 25,000 key configurations
