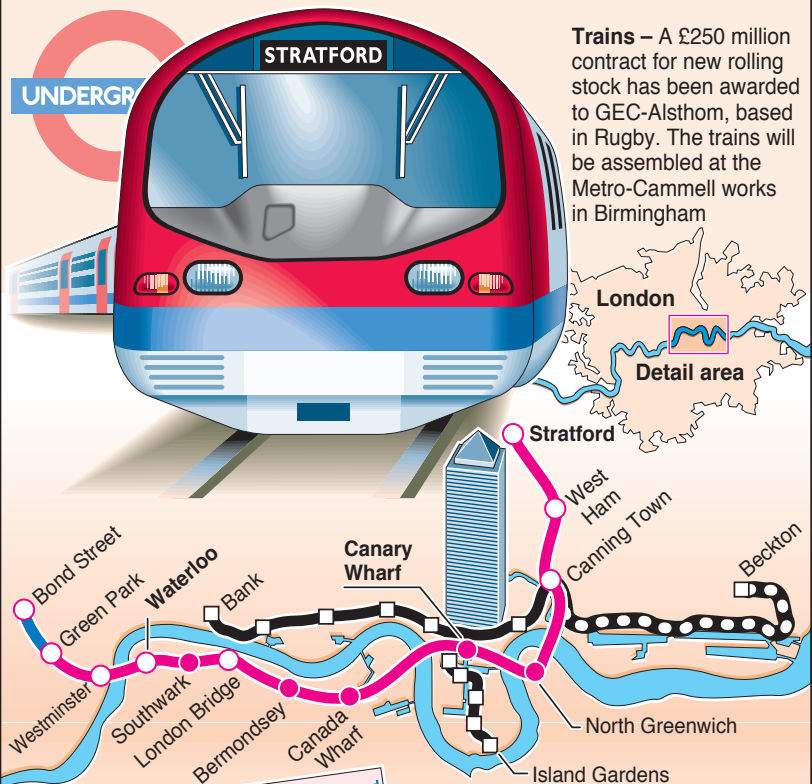


Jubilee celebration as digging begins

A ceremony at Canary Wharf on December 8 will herald the start of work on the long-awaited Jubilee Line extension, due for completion by Spring 1998. The £1.9 billion project, which will create 22,000 jobs nationwide, will cut the journey time from Waterloo to Canary Wharf to just ten minutes
