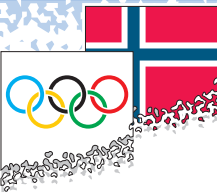


Norway's Olympic adventure

The 'Morgedal flame' – used at the 1952 Oslo Games and 1960 Squaw Valley Games – will complete its 8,000km journey, involving 7,000 runners, in Lillehammer. The flame will burn in the cauldron used at the Oslo Games until the arrival of the Olympic flame from Greece
