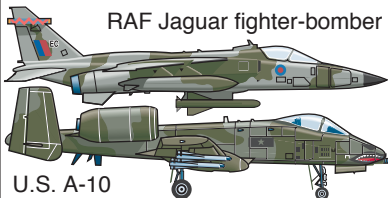


NATO air strikes

NATO air attacks in Bosnia

Feb 28 1994: American F-16 fighters shoot down four Bosnian Serb 'Super Galeb' jets violating no-fly zone near Banja Luka – first shots ever fired in anger by NATO

March 12: U.N. requests airstrike following Serb attack on French peacekeepers. Planes sent, but do not open fire

April 10: Two U.S. F-16s bomb Bosnian Serb positions near Gorazde

April 11: Two U.S. Marine FA-18s strike Serb positions near Gorazde – tank destroyed

April 16: British Sea Harrier jump-jet downed near Gorazde by ground fire. Pilot ejects – rescued by Bosnian forces

Aug. 5: Two U.S. A-10 tank busters destroy anti-tank weapon near Sarajevo following Serb seizure of weapons from U.N. compound

Sept. 22: NATO jets destroy Serb tank in no-weapons zone around Sarajevo after Serbs attack French armored personnel carrier
