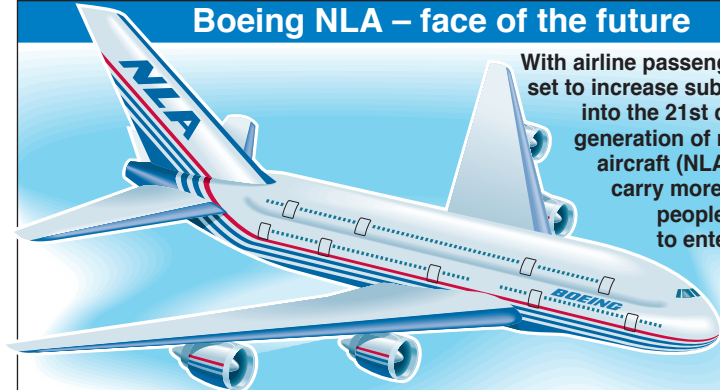


Boeing NLA – face of the future



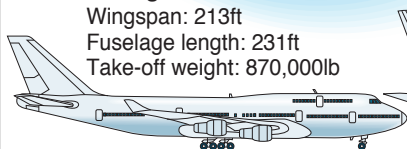

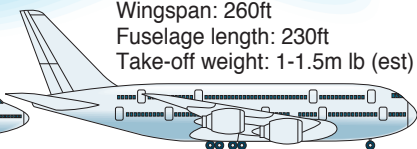


Proposed NLA – 606 seats

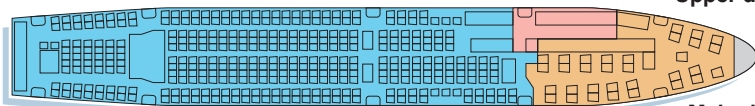

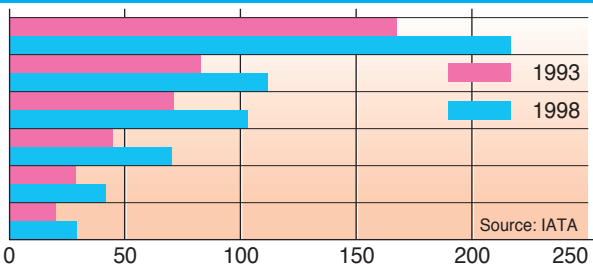
