


# Major terrorist car bomb attacks

**1. Oklahoma City – 19 Apr '95:** 31 dead, including 12 children, over 200 injured and 250-300 people missing in blast at U.S. Federal building

**2. New York – 26 Feb '93:** Six killed and 1,000 injured when car bomb explodes at New York World Trade Centre. Four Islamic radicals convicted of bombing

**3. London – 26 Jul '94:** Bomb in car boot damages Israeli Embassy injuring 14. Second bomb explodes outside building housing Jewish organizations in north London

**4. Madrid – 19 Apr '95:** 15 injured as ETA car bomb fails to kill Spanish opposition leader

**5. Algiers – 30 Jan '95:** Islamic extremists detonate car bomb outside police station, killing 42 people and wounding 286

**6. Florence – 27 May '93:** Car bomb outside Italy's Uffizi Gallery kills five and destroys centuries-old works of art

**7. Gaza Strip – 9 Apr '95:** Eight killed and over 40 wounded in two bombings by Islamic militants

**8. Tel Aviv – 19 Oct '94:** Twenty people killed, 48 wounded when Palestinian suicide bomber blows up bus in shopping district

**9. Israel – 6 Apr '94:** Palestinian car bomb destroys bus in the Israeli town of Afula, killing nine and wounding 45

**10. West Bank – 4 Oct '93:** Palestinian drives car bomb into a bus outside Israeli military headquarters, wounding 29

**11. Iraq – 27 Feb '95:** Car bomb kills 94 in crowded bazaar

**12. Johannesburg – 27 Apr '94:** Car bomb explodes at airport during South Africa's first all-race election. Eighteen people injured

**13. Buenos Aires – 18 Jul '94:** Suspected Islamic terrorists detonate car bomb, destroying building housing Jewish groups. 95 killed, more than 200 injured
