

Key points in the Israel-PLO agreement



Redeployment: Israel's army to withdraw from cities of Jenin, Nablus, Tulkarm, Qalqilya, Ramallah and Bethlehem, and from 450 towns and villages. **Police:** Israel-PLO joint patrols to escort Israelis through Palestinian areas. PLO police will not have power to arrest Israelis

Elections: Palestinians will elect an 82-member self-rule council



with executive and legislative powers, and a head of the executive authority, or president. Elections will be held 22 days after Israel finishes withdrawing from West Bank cities and towns. The PLO wants elections by Jan 20

Authority: Palestinians will have full control over the major towns. Israel has final say over maintaining public order and combating terrorism in other Palestinian towns



Water: Israel to increase amount of water for

Palestinians. Joint committee will manage resources and enforce policy



Holy sites: Controlled by the

Palestinians except for Tomb of the Patriarchs in Hebron, with special arrangements for Rachel's Tomb in Bethlehem and Joseph's Tomb in Nablus. Freedom to worship at holy sites
