

# Tunnel keeps Palestinian anger running high

Israel defied world opinion by reopening a tunnel near Jerusalem's Muslim holy shrines, but agreed to a summit in Washington in an attempt to revive peace talks and end the violence that has taken 73 lives. Palestinians, frustrated at a stalled peace-process, the expansion of Jewish settlements, and their wrecked economy, attacked the opening of the tunnel as an attempt to Judaize Jerusalem
