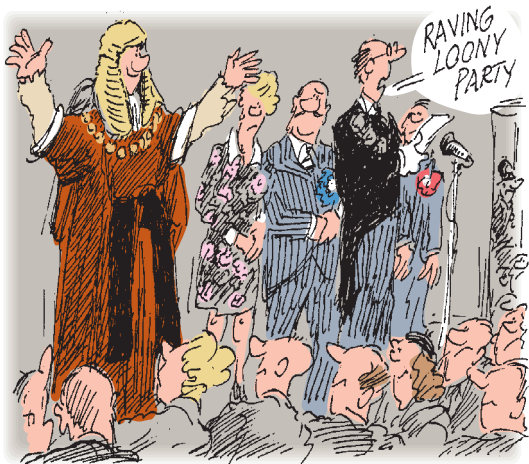


Who can be a candidate?



Many professional people are ineligible to become members of parliament, even if otherwise qualified for candidature

Civil servants, clergymen, police, the armed forces, judges and members of certain judicial commissions are excluded, as are undischarged bankrupts and anyone who commits a corrupt or illegal election practice. In campaigning, candidates are not allowed to use force, threat or fraud to compel a voter at poll-time, or to 'treat' them to meat, drink, entertainment or provisions
