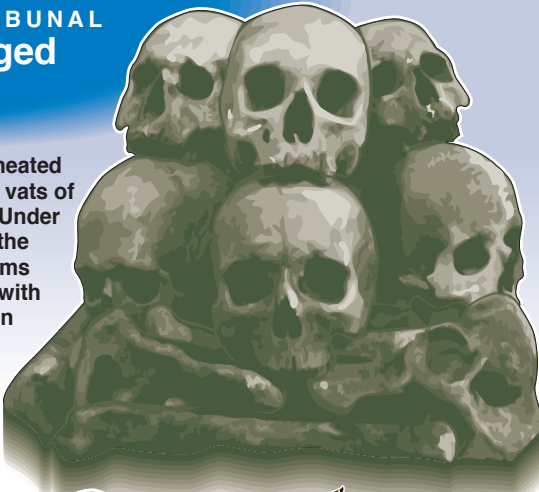


WAR CRIMES TRIBUNAL

Trial over alleged atrocity camp


Gang rape. Torture with heated scissors, confinement to vats of water and mass murder. Under an indictment issued by the U.N. tribunal, three Muslims and a Croat are charged with atrocities against Serbs in the *Celebici* prison camp in central Bosnia, where at least 14 Serbs allegedly died horrible deaths and many more were tortured






 **Britain:** First war crimes trial collapsed when **Szymon Serafinowicz**, 86, declared mentally unfit to stand trial

 **The Hague:** Trial begins of officers **Zejnir Delalic**, **Zdravko Mucic**, **Hazim Delic** and camp guard **Esad Landzo** – charged with war crimes at the Muslim-controlled *Celebici* camp



 **France:** **Maurice Papon**, 86, last surviving Vichy official, to be tried for complicity in crimes against humanity

 **Italy:** Former SS captain **Erich Priebke** awaiting new trial after military tribunal ruling overturned by Supreme Court

 **Tanzania:** Former director of Rwanda's defence ministry, **Theoneste Bagasora**, accused of directing slaughter of around
