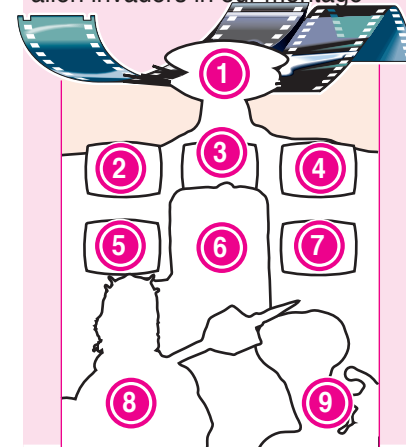


**...Keep watching the skies!
