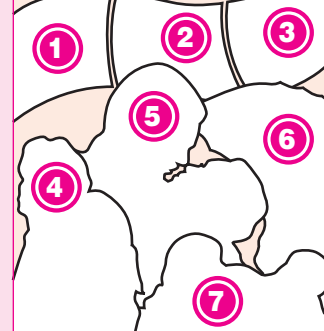


IF YOU haven't booked that table at the restaurant or that ticket to the theatre yet then you could be in trouble – so be sure you order the flowers!
