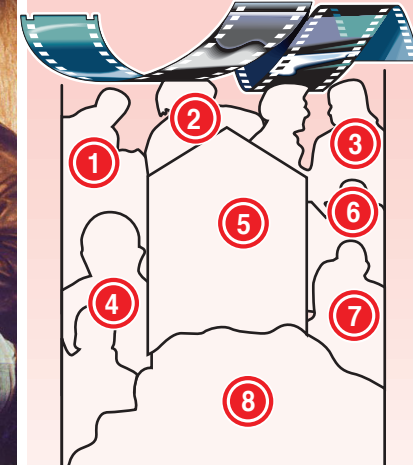




A DARK MISTY NIGHT, an open window, a pale, exposed neck – it must be time for dinner...
