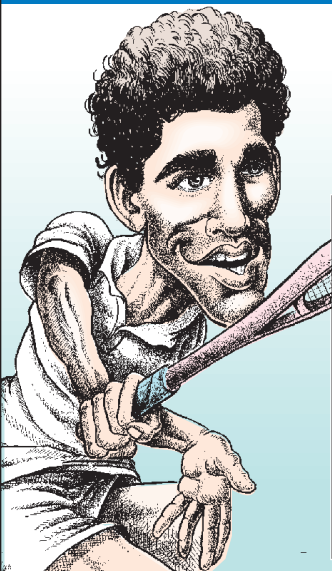


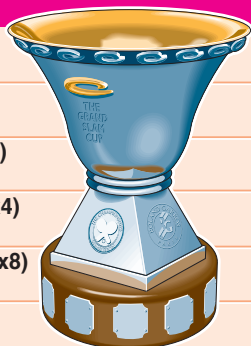
Grand Slam Cup 97 – the best of the best
