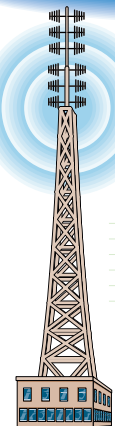


DIGITAL TELEVISION

The revolution will be televised

With U.S. and UK digital transmission to begin in November, couch potatoes should prepare themselves for a media revolution akin to the advent of colour television. In the UK, as many as 30 channels on terrestrial TV and 200 on satellite will be available in widescreen format with CD quality sound, offering a range of added features – but are they worth the investment?

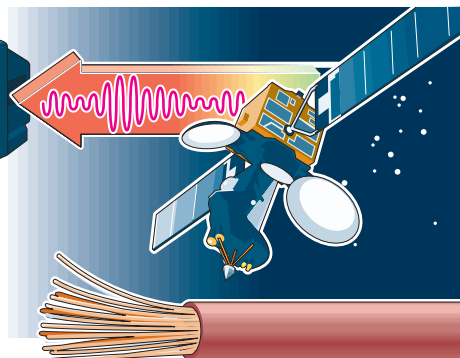
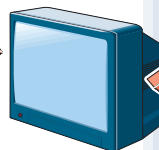
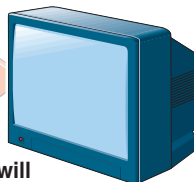


Carrier

Existing analogue: Each channel comprises a high frequency carrier signal modulated by a vision signal using 8MHz bandwidth



Digital TV (DTV): Series of binary on-off signals. Up to 10 digital channels will be able to occupy the frequency previously occupied by one analogue channel



Current satellite and cable TV: Broadcasts are similarly restricted in bandwidth by analogue transmission

Set-top boxes – to decode digital signals

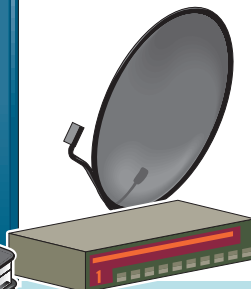
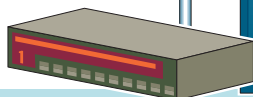
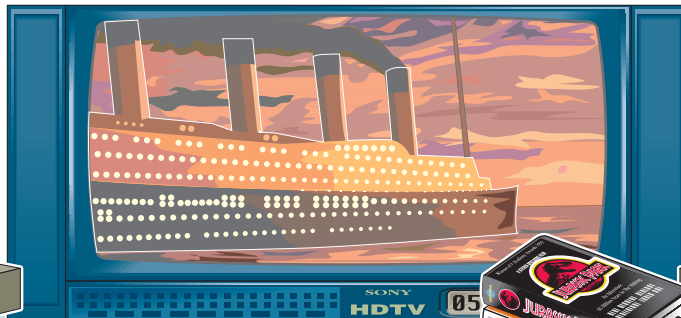
Buying a new digital wide-screen set – instead of using a set-top box – will be the recommended option: Price from £3,000

By Jan 2000 all new TVs in U.S. must also contain **V-chip** to block adult content

Digital satellite TV

Set-top boxes and new satellite dishes will be needed to receive new channels
Price from £300

Old aerials may need to be replaced or realigned
Price from £30



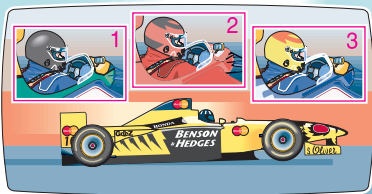
Your Choice TV: Staggered starting times of TV shows
