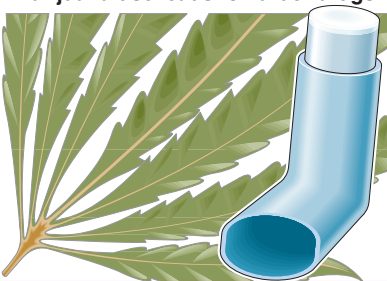






Clinical cannabis

The active ingredients in marijuana – called cannabinoids – can help fight pain and nausea and thus deserve to be tested in scientific trials, says a report published by the U.S. Institute of Medicine. The Institute also says there is no conclusive evidence that marijuana use leads to harder drugs
