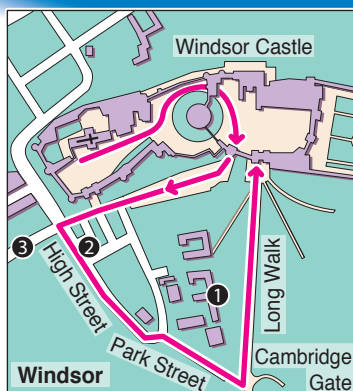


Wedding of Prince Edward and Miss Sophie Rhys-Jones

1. Royal Mews:

Two Ascot landaus will depart to carry the bridal party

2. Public tour:

Starts as landaus enter High Street

3. Street fair: With jugglers & carousels, held in Peascod St

4. Long Walk:

Carriages return to Windsor Castle

1.30pm: 6,000 ticket-holding members of the general public admitted to castle precincts

3.30pm: Doors of St George's Chapel open for guests

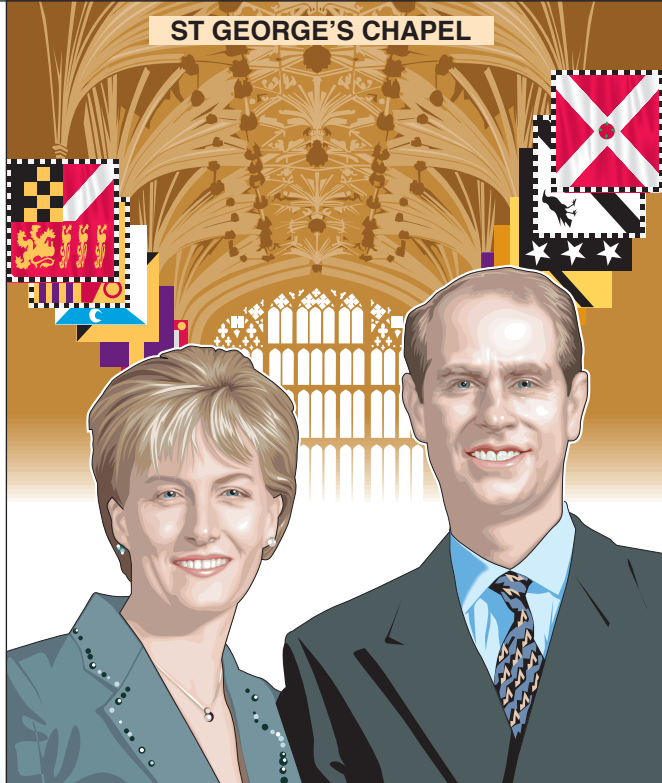
4.30pm: Members of British and other Royal Families arrive

4.40pm: Members of Rhys-Jones family arrive at the chapel

4.45pm: Groom and supporters arrive at the West Door, met by Dean and escorted to Bray Chapel

4.50pm: The Queen and The Duke of Edinburgh arrive at the West Door to be met by the Dean and Chapter

5pm: The bride and her father – preceded by bridesmaids and pages – arrive at the West Door
Service commences

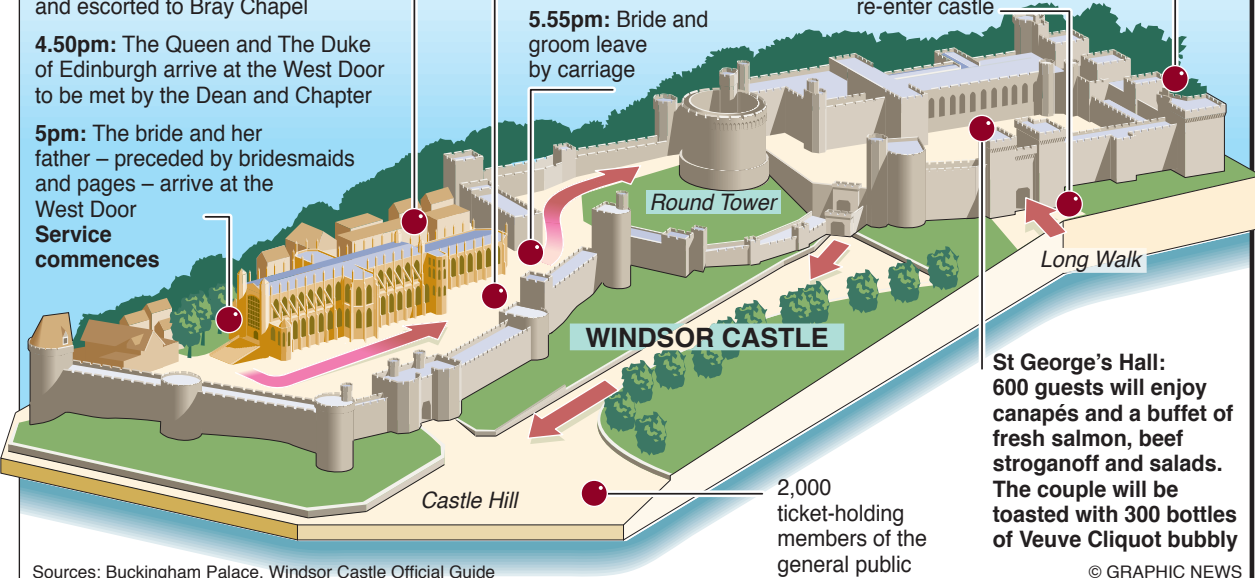


5.45pm: Service concludes. Bridal party leaves via the West Door and pose for photographs

5.55pm: Bride and groom leave by carriage

6pm: Reception begins in State Apartments

6.10pm: Bride and groom re-enter castle
