Feb 11, 2003: Third brother, *Ali Imron*, shows police how he helped assemble main car bomb

May 12: Amrozi goes on trial charged with planning and carrying out attacks

Jun 2: Trial of Samudra begins

Jun 16: Trial of Mukhlas begins

Jul 21: Trial of Imron begins

Aug 7: Bali court finds Amrozi

guilty – sentences him to death by firing squad

## Alleged links to al Qaeda

Abu Bakar Bashir: Spiritual leader of JI, arrested Oct 19, 2002, in connection with earlier terrorist bombings. In Jan 2003 police say Bashir approved Bali attack – Bashir denies any involvement

Hambali: Thought to be operational brain of JI. Alleged plotter of foiled al Qaeda attempt to blow up U.S. Embassy in Singapore in Dec 2001

Nov 2002: Tape attributed to Osama bin Laden praises Bali attack

Jul 2003: Alleged JI treasurer Wan Min Wan Mat tells Bali court that part of group's funding came from al Qaeda
