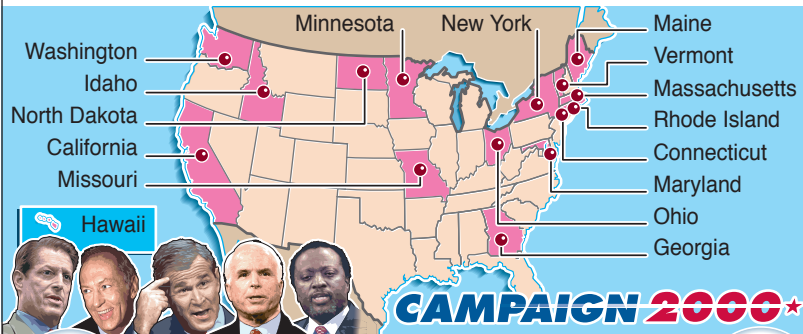


“Super Tuesday” – It’s Gore against Bush

Al Gore effectively won the Democratic presidential nomination on “Super Tuesday” while Republican favourite George W. Bush pushed his rival John McCain to the brink of extinction by winning the key contests. The presidential election on November 7 now pits Gore, the vice president and political heir of President Bill Clinton, against Bush, the governor of Texas and actual heir of former President George Bush
