**1931: Chicago mobster Al Capone was charged with 5,000 offences under U.S. prohibition laws**



**1667: Jean-Baptiste Denys, personal physician to Louis XIV of France, successfully transfused a sheep's blood into a 15-year-old-boy**

**1929: Anne Frank, the young Jewish girl immortalised by the diary she kept while in hiding from the Nazis, was born**

**1965: The four members of *The Beatles* were each awarded the MBE**

**1991: Boris Yeltsin became the first ever directly elected leader of the Russian Federation**

**1999: Actor DeForest Kelley, best known as Dr. McCoy in *Star Trek*, died at the age of 79**
