

# Britain details Iraq weapons

Iraq has "military plans" for the use of chemical and biological weapons and is seeking to buy "significant quantities" of fissile material from an unspecified African nation. According to a dossier, compiled by the British security services, Iraq could produce a nuclear weapons within two years



**1. Project Baiji, al-Sharqat:** Large new well-guarded chemical complex built at site of former uranium enrichment facility. Designed to produce nitric acid which can be used in the purification of uranium



**2. Ibn Sina Company, Tarmiyah:** New chemical research centre – built with illegal foreign assistance – believed ready for production. Director is *Hikmat Na'im al-Jalu* worked in both Iraq's nuclear and chemical weapons programmes
