

UN searches site disclosed in dossier

UN weapons inspectors have begun searching a newly-declared site near Baghdad – identified by the Iraqis in their weapons dossier – as their hunt for Iraq's alleged banned arsenal picked up the pace in its third week

Sites visited since inspections resumed November 27



1. **Al-Tahadi:** Military plant
2. **Ammariyyeh:** Graphite compound
3. **Dora:** Animal vaccine lab
4. **Taji:** Light ammunition and heavy civilian machinery factories
5. **Yusoufiyyah:** Arm of Military Industrialisation Commission (MIC) – complex originally planned for nuclear research
6. **Balad:** Army post with missile and ammunition warehouses
7. **Khan Bani Saad:** In 1988 Iraq declared site used in development of biological weapons
8. **Rashidiya:** MIC compounds
9. **Al-Sojoud:** Presidential palace
10. **Al-Tuwaitha:** Nuclear facility

11. **Al-Muthanna:** Alleged chemical agent and biological weapons facility

12. **Al-Iskandariyah:** MIC research complex in munitions engineering

13. **Fallujah:** Military and industrial complex, including pesticides factory

14. **State Mining facility:** Chemical laboratories, uranium processing

15. **Al-Qaim:** Uranium extraction facility destroyed in Gulf War

16. **Abu Ghurayb:** Associated with biological weapons before 1991

17. **Karamah:** Dec 11 – Inspectors visit “Strategic Storage Unit” – part of missile programme – following up information revealed in dossier
