

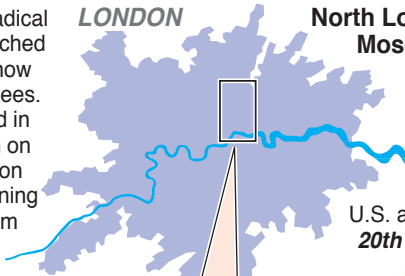
Militant connections of London mosque

A police raid on a mosque in North London's Finsbury Park was linked to the discovery of the deadly toxin ricin in the capital. While thousands regularly pray there, a militant minority at the mosque is alleged to have raised funds for terrorists and recruited young Muslims for violent *jihad*

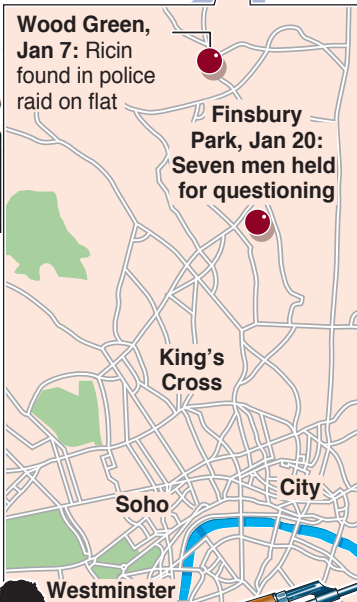
